In about 100 words, outline at least three ways in which a mobile phone's GPS capabilities can be used to provide benefits to users of a social network.

Mobile GPS is a great tool for users of a social network. Right off the bat the GPS can track user location and recommend relevant contacts or friends. If the location-based service knows you and one other person are 5 miles apart it would make sense for you to show up in each other's feeds. Past this the GPS can also help to recommend events, gatherings and food locations nearby.
